Power of Attorney for Health Care

Power of Attorney for Property

Living Will Declaration

Powers of Attorney documents give legal authority to a **person of your choosing** to make health care or property decisions on your behalf if you become unable to do so. Also, if you choose to complete one, a **living will declaration** is a document that instructs physicians and others not to take extraordinary measures (like life-support equipment) to prolong one's life in the event of a terminal condition. (A living will **does not prevent** your doctor from providing comfort care or the alleviation of pain.)
