### **What is Chore?**

The Chore Program provides a worker on a limited basis to perform basic household chores, errands, laundry, light meal preparation, and other tasks that are essential to independent living. Participants must be at least sixty years of age and assessed by a case manager for eligibility. A statement will be sent to recipients with a suggested contribution for services rendered, but no one is denied services based on their ability to pay.

CHORE is a light housekeeping program that is offered through OPTSS for seniors in Oak Park and River Forest. It is for seniors that do not qualify for services through the Community Care Program, yet still

need light housekeeping services. An OPTSS case manager will come to your home to assist you in determining your needs.

### **What do I have to pay?**

It is suggested that you contribute a monthly donation, which is based on your income and the amount of hours you receive. Together, you and your OPTSS case manager will determine this amount for you.

### **How many hours of service will be made available to me?**

Currently, due to high demand for this program, service is limited.

### **Who provides these services?**

A homemaker agency that is licensed and bonded through the State of Illinois.

### **What types of services are available?**

- Clean and tidy up the home
- Dust the home
- Sweep floors
- Vacuum floors
- Mop floors
- Collect and take out garbage
- Clean bathrooms
- Change towels and linens
- Make the bed
- Laundry or ironing
- Clean kitchen
- Light meal preparation
- Wash and dry the dishes
- Clean stove and/or oven
- Clean the refrigerator and/or freezer
