# RFCCA Board of Managers Regular Meeting Tuesday, October 17, 2023

### **RFCCA Facilities Administrator's Report** - Dick Chappell

• Minor roof leaks are being addressed following the recent heavy rains. An updated building alarm system will be addressed once construction is complete. Grants will be explored to support the cost of enhancing the building security system.

# **RFCC Executive Director's Report - Dick Chappell**

- The classroom renovations, while progressing, are behind schedule. One ongoing challenge has been the contractor accidentally setting off the fire alarm during RFCC programs. The classrooms are primarily complete (excluding punch list items and lighting). The new DCFS licensing review has not yet been scheduled however.
- The River Forest Police Department is emphasizing the need for a lock-down drill. The alarm for this could possibly be tied into the new phone system. The signal needs to be completely different from the fire alarms (so lock-down drills will be done when construction is complete).
- An Eagle Scout project to create a movable "book nook" in the RFCC lobby is now complete. Due to the ongoing construction, the book nook was temporarily removed until construction is complete.
- Director Chappell indicated filling RFCC staffing vacancies remains a challenge. He is working with Byline Bank to implement additional controls to reduce hacking attempts.
- The Park District pickleball program, including time slots for seniors, will soon return to RFCC in the mornings.
