HELPING YOUTH THROUGH THE LOCAL ADJUDICATION PROCESS

The **Community Justice Program** of Oak Park and River Forest Townships is a partnership with local adjudication offices to minimize youth entering the juvenile justice system.

Youth who have violated local ordinances can be referred to the Community Justice Program from local adjudication where they will complete community engagement hours, participate in restorative justice initiatives and other specific programming as a way to serve the community, help themselves, and fufill their assigned adjudication hours.

The Community Justice Program offers an alternative to the juvenile justice system by giving youth a chance to participate in the community through service, focus on their needs through counseling and other programming, learn life skills such as conflict resolution, and invest in themselves through job training and more.

This program provides a process that helps youth create and maintain a positive life direction.
